The Twin Cities Nyckelharpalag (TCNL)

Membership Policy

1. TCNL exists, in a large part, to provide learning and playing experiences for persons interested in playing traditional Swedish folk music, primarily from the province of Uppland, Sweden. As such, membership is open to all players, regardless of level, that play or wish to play traditional Uppland folk instruments. These instruments include first and foremost the Nyckelharpa, but also the Fiddle and Clarinet.
2. Instrument membership other than the forgoing instruments are limited and specific to the needs of TCNL. This is to assure that the Lag maintains an "Uppland sound" in its playing. Applications will be processed on a case-by-case basis.
3. With the exception of former members, applications for membership will be limited to persons living within reasonable commuting distance from the Minneapolis/St. Paul area. This is to encourage attendance at TCNL events and activities. Others are encouraged to join the American Nyckelharpa Association (ANA) as that organization is better positioned to support remote learning.
4. TCNL provides Members access to significant learning resources via workshops and a database connected to its proprietary website. These resources have been provided by contributing instructors and others. **By accessing these resources, Members and Associates acknowledge that such resources may not be distributed outside the TCNL organization, in written or electronic form, unless authorized by contributors of those materials. These materials include video, audio, sheet music, and other written materials accessible through TCNL's member portion of its website.**
